Belt led standards development projects and provided key engineering and technology policy support to CTA member groups. Tech standards produced under Belt's leadership are referenced by the EPA, DOE, FTC, FCC and other government agencies.

In addition, Belt represented CTA's technical interests in industry and international venues related to spectrum management and policy, accessibility, product safety and energy efficiency. He has participated in international development programs on standards including at the World Health Organization, International Telecommunication Union and International Energy Agency. He has presented at EPA, FAA, DOE and FCC workshops on a variety of subjects. He also serves on a number of high-level government advisory committees.

Belt is a frequent speaker at industry conferences and seminars and has been widely quoted in the press including The Economist, Bloomberg Business, and local media. He has traveled for business in dozens of countries, from Switzerland to China, from Brazil to Japan and India.

Prior to joining CTA, Belt worked as senior director at the Telecommunications Industry Association. Before that, he was a senior engineer at AT&T Wireless Services and a supervising engineer at the FCC. Belt holds a BS in electrical engineering from Syracuse University.
